1891 St. John Church

- ☛ Capacity: 75
- ☛ Description: 1891 historic church building noted for its simple beauty and lack of ornamentation; neoclassical structure with Gothic windows and shutters; octagonal steeple
- ☛ Restrictions: usage protocol will be provided



Connally Plaza

- ☛ Capacity (seated dinner): 250
- ☛ Capacity (reception): 500+
- ☛ Description: Beautifully landscaped brick patio dedicated to the memory of Texas Governor John Connally with magnificent oak tree and rose garden; surrounded by the 1823 Old Place, 1850 Nichols-Rice-Cherry House, and the 1866 Fourth Ward Cottage.



Tea Room

- ☛ Area: 1300 sq. ft.
- ☛ Capacity (seated dinner): 60
- ☛ Capacity (theater style): 100
- ☛ Capacity (reception): 150
- ☛ Description: long room with columns, hardwood floors and beautifully restored wooden bar from the Capital Hotel



Conference Room

- ☛ Area: 265 sq. ft.
- ☛ Capacity (meeting): 12
- ☛ Description: classic beige walls with white wood trim and hardwood floors, Early American chandelier, floor to ceiling windows, erasable white board and phone



Museum Gallery

- ☛ Area: 3000 sq. ft.
- ☛ Capacity (reception): 400
- ☛ Description: exhibition space consisting of two main galleries, a video room and a replica 19th century general store; contains a 1911 Ford Model T photographs of Houston taken between 1930 and 1980, and a collection of American brilliant cut glass



Facility Rental Information:


- Rental rates depend on the time of day and day of the week. Call The Heritage Society at 713.655.1912 for pricing.
- Rates include the event venue only. Catering, entertainment, and outside rentals are not included and must be arranged by and paid for by the client. Setup and breakdown time will be factored into the cost of the client's contract.
- Event dates are confirmed when executed contract and initial payment have been received.
- A damage deposit is required. The amount required is dependent upon the facilities rented. If no damages are assessed, the damage deposit will be returned to the client within 21 days after the event.
- Parking for a maximum of 80 vehicles may be available depending on the date and time of the event.
- Serving of alcoholic beverages is permitted on The Heritage Society property with a certified TABC server and adequate security for your guests.
- Setup and delivery of rentals, catering supplies, and/or entertainment must be arranged with The Heritage Society Facility Manager prior to the date of the event.
- Decorations must be pre-approved by The Heritage Society Facility Manager.

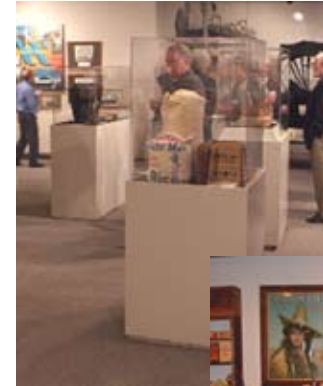
